Day 1: Saturday, March 6, 2027: Depart the US

The day has arrived, and we depart Phoenix (PHX) on an overnight journey to Israel.

Day 2: Sunday, March 7, 2027: Arrive in Israel

Today we arrive in Israel at Tel Aviv's Ben Gurion Airport. Upon arrival we meet our Christian Expedition Tour Director, who will remain with us for the duration of our trip. We will drive to the area of Galilee. Conditions and regulations permitting, we will enjoy a welcome bonfire on the shores of the Sea of Galilee. Overnight Sea of Galilee area. Prima Galil or similar D.

Day 3: Monday, March 8, 2027: Caesarea, Mount Carmel, Megiddo, Nazareth Village.

After breakfast we board a private coach, which brings us to Caesarea Maritima (included), on the Mediterranean Sea. Acts 10 tells us that the Gentile Cornelius received a vision at Caesarea, which prompted him to send for the Apostle Peter, who then came to Caesarea and preached the Gospel to Cornelius and those assembled at his house. All those who heard the message received the Holy Spirit! In Caesarea, we visit the Roman Amphitheatre, hippodrome, and an ancient aqueduct. We then head to Mt. Carmel (included), where Elijah confronted Baal and his prophets, and God sent fire from heaven in response to Elijah's prayer. (1 Kings 18). Then we head to the Jezreel Valley, to Tel Megiddo (included). We drive past the area of Cana and come to Nazareth, the hometown of Jesus. Here we will visit Nazareth Village, a re-creation of life in Nazareth at the time of Jesus. Overnight Sea of Galilee area. Prima Galil or similar. B, L, D.

Day 4: Tuesday, March 9, 2027: Mount of Beatitudes, Ancient Boat Museum and Boat Ride, Tabgha, Capernaum, Magdala.

This morning we make our way to the Mount of the Beatitudes. We move on to see the Ancient Galilee boat (included), which was discovered in 1986, and was used for fishing on the Sea of Galilee in the First Century AD. We enjoy a cruise on the Sea of Galilee (included), which includes a Scripture reading and devotional by your trip chaplain. We go on to Capernaum (included), where we see the remains of the village, including the home of Peter. We will also visit Tabgha, where Jesus appeared to his disciples after his resurrection. We enjoy a "St. Peter's Fish Lunch," of fish from the sea of Galilee (included, non-fish options are also available). We then head to Magdala (included), the hometown of Mary Magdalene, which also boasts the remains of a First Century synagogue. We will enjoy kayaking/rafting on the Jordan River (included). Overnight Sea of Galilee area. Prima Galil or similar. B, L, D.

Day 5: Wednesday, March 10, 2027: Yardenit, Beth Shean, Gan Hashlosha

This morning we will visit Yardenit, the Jordan River baptismal site, where there will be an opportunity to be baptized in the same river as was Jesus. We will head south, leaving the region of Galilee, and visit Beth Shean, where the body of King Saul was affixed to the city walls after his defeat at the hands of the Philistines. We will enjoy a picnic lunch at Gan Hashlosha, a national park with springs and natural pools. We drive south through the Jordan Valley, getting a sense of Israel's agricultural fertility, which caused

it to be called a "Land of Milk and Honey." We pass by Jericho, which God famously gave into the hands of Joshua and the Israelites, and which is regarded as the oldest city in the world. Overnight Jerusalem. Jerusalem Gardens or similar. B, L, D.

Day 6: Thursday, March 11, 2027: Temple Mount, Ecce Homo, St. Anne's and Pools of Bethesda, Southern Wall Excavations, Bethlehem

Today we see Jerusalem. We visit the Temple Mount, where the first two temples stood. We visit the Antonia Fortress (included), where Jesus was condemned to die by Pontius Pilate. We see the Pool of Bethesda where, John 5 recounts, Jesus healed a disabled man; Stephen's Gate, also known as the Lion's Gate or the Sheep Gate; St. Anne's Church (included), which was built during the Middle Ages by Crusaders; and the site of the excavation of the Southern Wall (included), which served as the south side of the second temple. It through this wall that Jesus entered the Temple before His cleansing of it. It is believed that this is where Peter preached on the Day of Pentecost (Acts 2). We enjoy a cooking class, led by a local chef, and spend the rest of the day in Bethlehem, the birthplace of Christ. Overnight Jerusalem. Jerusalem Gardens or similar. B, L, D.

Day 7: Friday, March 12, 2027: Masada, Ein Gedi, Genesis Land, Dead Sea, Rabbinical Tunnels, Wailing Wall

After breakfast, we will depart from Jerusalem and enjoy a sunrise hike up to Masada, the mountain-top fortress that served as the site of a famous zealot last stand. We head, then, to Ein Gedi, or the "Spring of the Goat," a natural oasis famous for its flora and fauna on the western shore of the Dead Sea. 1 Samuel 24 tells us that it was at Ein Gedi that David hid from Saul in a cave, and spared Saul's life. Here we experience an Ein Gedi Waterfalls hike. We visit Kfar Hanokdim or Genesis Land, a desert experience including Bedouin hospitality and a camel ride. In the afternoon we enjoy our free time at one of the beaches of the Dead Sea, enjoying its healing properties and mud. In the evening we enjoy the visit of the Rabbinical Tunnels and the Wailing Wall. Overnight Jerusalem. Jerusalem Gardens or similar. B, L, D.

Day 8: Saturday, March 13, 2027: Mount of Olives, Gethsemane, Upper Room, Via Dolorosa, Garden Tomb

We begin the day by heading to the Mount of Olives. The Mount of Olives provides an incredible view of Jerusalem, Mount Moriah and the Dome of the Rock. We visit the Garden of Gethsemane, where Jesus agonized on the night before his crucifixion. We move on to the "Upper Room," where Jesus and his disciples ate the Last Supper. We walk the Via Dolorosa, and visit the Church of the Holy Sepulcher.

Finally, we visit the Garden Tomb (donation included), where some believe Jesus was buried and later resurrected. Tonight we will enjoy a farewell dinner. Your flight home may depart either late tonight or the following day. If the following day and an overnight is required, overnight Jerusalem. Jerusalem Gardens or similar.

Day 9: Sunday, March 14, 2027: Arrive at Home

Your flight home may depart either the previous night or today. If today and time allows, breakfast is included today. Either way, today we will arrive back in Phoenix (PHX).

Itineraries: Itineraries are prepared and scheduled in advance according to the best information available at the time and are subject to change by the date of the trip.
Pricing: Christian Expedition, Inc. ("CE") reserves the right to adjust pricing should the following occur; (1) Rise in Airfare due to higher fuel costs, etc. (2) Rise in ground costs due to increases in hotel charges, bus fares, fees, taxes and other costs due to the fluctuating value of the U.S. dollar against foreign currency.
Deposits and final payments: A deposit of \$450.00 per person is required to hold your reservation of which \$200 is non-refundable (may be refundable under travel insurance conditions). Final payment is due 90 days prior to the departure date. Payment can be made by credit card or check. Call (877) 234-3002 to make a credit card payment.
Cancellation fees: For cancellations received less than 90 days prior to the original departure date (even in the case of postponement), the initial deposit of \$450 plus any non-recoverable expenses associated with your reservation incurred by CE will be non-refundable. These expenses may include, but are not limited to, charges imposed by the airlines, hotels, and bus companies, the cost of labor associated with the servicing of your reservation, and the costs assessed for the use of our reservation system, as determined or estimated by CE.
