Itinerary (Subject to change)

March 23-29, 2025

Day 1: Sunday, March 23, 2025: Arrive in Washington, D.C.

Today we arrive in the Washington, D.C. metro area, and the remainder of the day will be spent at leisure. Tonight we will enjoy a welcome dinner together. Overnight Washington, D.C. Area. Hilton Garden Inn or similar. D.

Day 2: Monday, March 24: Monuments, Memorials

This morning we visit the Lincoln Memorial before making our way to D.C.'s World War II Memorial, dedicated to Americans who served during the Second World War and containing 56 pillars which represent the U.S. states and territories. We visit the Washington Monument, before moving on to the White House (exterior views only). Then, to the nearby World War I Memorial, where we see sculptor Sabin Howard's impressive work, *A Soldier's Journey*. In the afternoon, we will visit Ford's Theater, where Abraham Lincoln was shot, and the Petersen House, where he died. We will enjoy a night tour of Washington, D.C., the Lincoln Memorial, the Vietnam Veterans Memorial, and the Korean War Veterans Memorial. Overnight Washington, D.C. Area. Hilton Garden Inn or similar. B, D.

Day 3: Tuesday, March 25: Government Buildings

Today we visit the U.S. Capitol Building, the Visitor's Center, the Crypt, the Rotunda, and the National Statuary Hall. We visit the Library of Congress and U.S. Supreme Court Building (external views only). We explore the Tidal Basin, a reservoir between the Potomac River and the Washington Channel which each spring serves as the focal point of the National Cherry Blossom Festival. We visit the Franklin Delano Roosevelt Memorial, the Martin Luther King, Jr. National Memorial, and the Jefferson Memorial. We will also visit the National Archives, the home of the Declaration of Independence, Constitution, and Bill of Rights. Overnight Washington, D.C. Area. Hilton Garden Inn or similar. B, D.

Day 4: Wednesday, March 26: Mount Vernon, Spy Museum

This morning we drive to Mount Vernon, where we visit the former estate of George Washington. We will tour the mansion and grounds and stop for lunch at the food court. We will then return to D.C., where we will visit the International Spy Museum, which is dedicated to the history of espionage. Overnight Washington, D.C. Area. Hilton Garden Inn or similar. B, D.

Day 5: Thursday, March 27: Museum of the Bible, National Zoo

This morning we visit the Museum of the Bible, where we will learn about the Bible's contents, history, and impact on humanity. In the afternoon we will visit the Smithsonian National Zoological Park, one of the oldest zoos in the United States, featuring Asian elephants, Sumatran tigers, and much more. Overnight Washington, D.C. Area. Hilton Garden Inn or similar. B, D.

Day 6: Friday, March 28: Smithsonian Museum, Arlington

This morning we visit the National Air and Space Museum, which is dedicated to human flight and space exploration. If time allows, we will also visit another of the Smithsonian Museums. Then we visit Arlington National Cemetery, a military cemetery where dead from America's wars are buried. We visit the gravesites of John F. Kennedy and Jacqueline Kennedy, where an "eternal flame" burns. We visit the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier and witness the Changing of the Guard. The Tomb of the Unknown Soldier is a monument dedicated to U.S. service members who have perished and whose remains have not been identified. The changing of the guard takes place every half hour. We visit the Arlington House, which was built between 1802 and 1818, with the original intention that it would serve as both the home of George Washington Parke Custis and a memorial to Custis' adoptive grandfather, George Washington. Custis' daughter married Robert E. Lee in the house in 1831. It would later be owned by Robert E. Lee, and is now a memorial to him. We will stop for a photo at the Marine Corps War Memorial, which honors members of the United States Marines who have given their lives for their country since 1775. The statue here depicts the raising of the American flag on Iwo Jima. From this memorial we enjoy a panoramic view of the Lincoln Memorial, the Washington Monument, and the Capitol building. Tonight we will enjoy a farewell dinner together. Overnight Washington, D.C. Area. Hilton Garden Inn or similar. B, D.

Day 7: Saturday, March 29: Return Home

Today we make our way to the airport, and begin our journey home. If your flight schedule permits, breakfast is included today.



Terms of Service

Itineraries: Itineraries are prepared and scheduled in advance according to the best information available at the time and are subject to change by the date of the trip.

Pricing: Christian Expedition, Inc. reserves the right to adjust pricing should the following occur; (1) Rise in Airfare due to higher fuel costs, etc. (2) Rise in ground costs due to increases in hotel charges, bus fares, fees, taxes and other costs due to the fluctuating value of the U.S. dollar against foreign currency.

Deposits and final payments: A deposit of \$450.00 per person is required to hold your reservation of which \$200 is non-refundable (may be refundable under travel insurance conditions). Final payment is due 60 days prior to the departure date. Payment can be made by credit card or check. Call (877) 234-3002 to make a credit card payment.

Cancellation fees: For cancellations received less than 60 days prior to the original departure date (even in the case of postponement), the initial deposit of \$450 plus any non-recoverable expenses associated with your reservation incurred by CE will be non-refundable. These expenses may include, but are not limited to, charges imposed by the airlines, hotels, and bus companies, the cost of labor associated with the servicing of your reservation, and the costs assessed for the use of our reservation system, as determined or estimated by CE. Please note that the amount may vary with each trip and the vendors we work with. CE retains the exclusive right to cancel or postpone any trip up to the departure date. If a trip is cancelled by CE all funds received will be returned within 10 business days. If a trip is postponed by CE the cancellation fees enumerated above will remain in effect.

Baggage: Please follow the general rule of traveling light - If you cannot carry it do not bring it. Passengers are permitted one piece of luggage per person. Baggage handling is included for one suitcase per person only, whenever possible, in the cost of the trip. The airlines for international flights will not allow a suitcase exceeding 50 pounds (subject to change), if over 50lbs., the fees can be costly. Every effort will be made to handle luggage carefully, however Christian Expedition, Inc. will not assume any liability for lost or damaged luggage or items inside luggage carrier. (Travel insurance may apply)

Travel insurance: We strongly recommend the purchase of travel insurance (personal accident/trip cancellation/baggage insurance). Christian Expedition, Inc. cannot accept responsibility for accidents, trip cancellations, or handling of baggage not under our control. All categories of insurance may be purchased from Christian Expedition as provided by Allianz Travel Insurance.

CE will not be responsible for any loss incurred by traveler, including lost days of the scheduled tour, due to a cancelled flight or other means and modes of transportation. Eligibility: This trip is intended for homeschool students and their families. Home school students who will be under 18 of age at the time of the travel must be accompanied by an adult.
