May 3 - 7, 2027

Day 1: Monday, May 3, 2027: Arrival in Tennessee & Welcome to the Smokies

Today we fly from West Palm Beach International Airport (PBI) to McGhee Tyson Airport (TYS) in Knoxville. Upon arrival, the group will board their charter bus for the scenic 1.5-hour drive to Gatlinburg, where they'll check into their mountain-view lodge-style cabin(s). After dinner, the group will enjoy a walk through The Island at Pigeon Forge to see the fountains and lights, followed by a relaxing first night back at the cabin(s). D.

Day 2: Tuesday, May 4, 2027: Dollywood

After breakfast, we head straight to Dollywood for a full day of fun. Students will enjoy thrilling roller coasters like Thunderhead, Tennessee Tornado, and Lightning Rod, along with shows, artisan shops, and Dollywood's famous Grist Mill cinnamon bread. B, L, D.

Day 3: Wednesday, May 5, 2027: Great Smoky Mountains & Gatlinburg Attractions

After breakfast, we venture into Great Smoky Mountains National Park for a scenic visit. We'll hike the Laurel Falls Trail, a popular 2.6-mile round-trip walk to a beautiful 80-foot waterfall. After photos and time in the mountain air, we'll drive the Newfound Gap Road for a few pull-off views of the Appalachian landscape, and stop briefly at the Tennessee-North Carolina state line. In the afternoon, the group will enjoy two student-favorite activities:

- A visit to Ripley's Aquarium of the Smokies, home to sharks, stingrays, penguins, and underwater tunnels.

- A ride up the Gatlinburg SkyLift to experience the SkyBridge, the longest pedestrian suspension bridge in North America.

We will enjoy dinner together, followed by souvenir shopping and free time on the Gatlinburg Strip before returning to the cabin(s). B, L, D.

Day 4: Thursday, May 6, 2027: Pigeon Forge Fun

After breakfast, we will visit The Island in Pigeon Forge, where you will be able to enjoy attractions like:

- A ride on the Great Smoky Mountain Wheel (not included)

- A group experience on the SkyFly Soar America indoor flying simulator (not included)

- Time to explore shops, snack stands, and arcade games

In the afternoon, we'll head to Outdoor Gravity Park for a fun and memorable zorbing experience—rolling downhill inside giant inflatable balls. B, L, D.

Day 5: Friday, May 7, 2027: Departure Day

After breakfast we will board the bus back to McGhee Tyson Airport (TYS) in Knoxville for our return flight to West Palm Beach, where we will arrive later in the day. B.

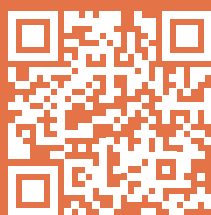

Terms of Service

Itineraries: Itineraries are prepared and scheduled in advance according to the best information available at the time and are subject to change by the date of the trip.

Pricing: Christian Expedition, Inc. reserves the right to adjust pricing should the following occur: (1) Rise in Airfare due to higher fuel costs, etc. (2) Rise in ground costs due to increases in hotel charges, bus fares, fees, taxes and other costs due to the fluctuating value of the U.S. dollar against foreign currency.

Deposits and final payments: A deposit of \$450.00 per person is required to hold your reservation of which \$200 is non-refundable (may be refundable under travel insurance conditions). Final payment is due 90 days prior to the departure date. Payment can be made by credit card or check. Call (877) 234-3002 to make a credit card payment.

Cancellation fees: For cancellations received 90 days or more in advance of the trip's original departure date, all monies paid are refundable less \$200 per person. For cancellations received less than 90 days prior to the original departure date (even in the case of postponement), the initial deposit of \$450 plus any non-recoverable expenses associated with your reservation incurred by CE will be non-refundable. These expenses may include, but are not limited to, charges imposed by the airlines, hotels, and bus companies, the cost of labor associated with the servicing of your reservation, and the costs assessed for the use of our reservation system, as determined or estimated by CE. Please note that the amount may vary with each trip and the vendors we work with. CE retains the exclusive right to cancel or postpone any trip up to the departure date. If a trip is cancelled by CE all funds received will be returned within 10 business days. If a trip is postponed by CE the cancellation fees enumerated above will remain in effect.

Baggage: Please follow the general rule of traveling light - If you cannot carry it do not bring it. Passengers are permitted one piece of luggage per person. Baggage handling is included for one suitcase per person only, whenever possible, in the cost of the trip. The airlines for international flights will not allow a suitcase exceeding 50 pounds (subject to change), if over 50lbs., the fees can be costly. Every effort will be made to handle luggage carefully, however Christian Expedition, Inc. will not assume any liability for lost or damaged luggage or items inside luggage carrier. (Travel insurance may apply)
