FOOTSTEPS OF PAUL WITH CALVARY PORT ST. LUCIE | JUNE 5 - 17, 2027

DAY 1: SATURDAY, JUNE 5, 2027 | DEPART THE US

The day has arrived and we board our motorcoach which will take us from Calvary Port St. Lucie to the airport in Miami (MIA). Once at the airport, we begin our overnight air journey to Greece.

DAY 2: SUNDAY, JUNE 6, 2027 | ARRIVE IN GREECE

Today we arrive in Greece at Thessaloniki airport (SKG). We will be met by our guide and driver and will transfer to our hotel. Whatever remains of the day will be spent at leisure. Overnight Thessaloniki. Grand Palace Hotel or similar. D.

DAY 3: MONDAY, JUNE 7, 2027 | KAVALA, PHILIPPI, THESSALONIKI

After breakfast, we follow the route of the Via Egnatia to Kavala – the ancient Neapolis – where the Apostle Paul first made landfall on European soil. We see the harbor and a mural dedicated to his arrival. We then proceed to Philippi, where we visit the Baptistery of Lydia near the river, the site where Paul baptized her – the first convert on European soil. We also explore the ruins of the Forum, the ancient Christian Basilicas, the theater, and the prison where it is believed Paul was once held. We return to Thessaloniki (biblical Thessalonica), where we see both the Upper Town, including the traditional House of Jason, as well as the lower town including the harbor and the city's famous White Tower. Overnight Thessaloniki. Grand Palace Hotel or similar. B, D.

DAY 4: TUESDAY, JUNE 8, 2027 | VERIA, VERGINA

After breakfast, we depart for Vergina, where we visit the remarkable museum housing four ancient tombs – most notably those of Philip II and Alexander IV – as well as a small shrine known as the Heroes Garden. We then travel to Veria, the biblical Berea, built at the foot of Mount Vermio, where Paul fled after causing a riot in Thessalonica. Here the people searched the Scriptures to see whether what Paul

was teaching was true (Acts 17:10-11). We visit the Step of the Apostle Paul, a platform dedicated to his preaching to the Bereans, as well as the city's synagogue – the most ancient in Northern Greece. We proceed to the region of Kalambaka.



Overnight Kalambaka. Divani Meteora Hotel or similar. B, D.

DAY 5: WEDNESDAY, JUNE 9, 2027 | METEORA, DRIVE TO ATHENS

Today we will visit one or more of the world-famous Meteora Monasteries, Byzantine monasteries that are perched on the

summits of gray rock peaks. Their history goes back to the 14th century when monks sought refuge in the cliff-side caves, then fled higher to build the original wooden shelters, which were later transformed into monasteries. We then drive to Athens, where whatever remains of the day will be spent at leisure. Overnight Athens. Wyndham Grand or similar. B, D.

DAY 6: THURSDAY, JUNE 10, 2027 | CORINTH, ATHENS

After breakfast, we depart for Ancient Corinth – the once-glorious city near the Isthmus, where Paul met Aquila and Priscilla and spent a year and a half preaching the Word of God (Acts 18). We visit the Archaeological Museum, the Forum, the Temples, and the famous Bema where Paul stood before Gallio, accused by the Jews of Corinth. We then drive to Cenchreae, the small harbor from which Paul sailed back to Asia, thus ending his second missionary journey. We return to Athens, where we follow our guide to the world-renowned Acropolis, taking in the Propylaea, the Erechtheion, and the Parthenon. We visit Mars Hill, where Paul delivered his speech on the Unknown God (Acts 17). We also see the Agora, the ancient center of economic and public life, where Paul preached to the skeptical Athenians. During our bus tour we see Constitution Square with the House of Parliament and the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, the Temple of Zeus, the Old Olympic Stadium, and the neoclassical buildings of Athens. Free time in the city center. Overnight Athens. Wyndham Grand Athens or similar. B, D.



DAY 7: FRIDAY, JUNE 11, 2027 | EMBARKATION, MYKONOS

After breakfast, we make our way to Lavrion Port and embark on our cruise. We sail to the quaint isle of Mykonos – the island of windmills. Upon arrival, we disembark and have time to experience the waterfront lined with shops and cafes, strolling the charming walkways through a maze of whitewashed buildings. No excursions are included today, as we explore the island at our leisure. Overnight on board. B, L, D.

DAY 8: SATURDAY, JUNE 12, 2027 | KUSADASI, PATMOS

In the morning, we arrive in Kusadasi, Turkey. A short drive takes us to Ephesus, where Paul spent three years during his ministry. The impressive remains include the Agora, the Theater, the Stadium, the Library of Celsus, and the ruins of the Temple of Diana – one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. In the afternoon, we sail for the island of Patmos, where we visit the Monastery of St. John, perched on one of the island's highest points. From there, we walk down

to the Grotto of the Apocalypse – the site of the apocalyptic visions of St. John the Divine. Overnight on board. B, L, D.

(Ephesus and Patmos excursions included.).

DAY 9: SUNDAY, JUNE 13, 2027 | CRETE, SANTORINI

In the morning, we arrive at Heraklion, Crete. We take a short ride through the town and arrive at the Knossos excavations, where Sir Arthur Evans'

archaeological discoveries revealed a civilization dating back to 4000 BC. Paul left Titus in Crete and gave instructions on appointing church leaders in the towns (Titus 1:5ff). In the afternoon, we cruise to the isle of Santorini – often called the most breathtaking of all the Greek islands – and disembark to explore the exquisite whitewashed villages, including the town of Fira, which cling to volcanic cliffs. Overnight on board. B, L, D. (Crete and Santorini excursions not included.).

DAY 10: MONDAY, JUNE 14, 2027 | DISEMBARK, ROME

After breakfast, we disembark at Lavrion Port and transfer to Athens Airport for our flight to Rome (FCO). Upon arrival, we meet our local guide and begin a walking tour of Baroque Rome, taking in the iconic Spanish Steps, Piazza Navona, the Trevi Fountain, and the Pantheon. Overnight Rome. Hotel Orazio Palace or similar. B, D.

DAY 11: TUESDAY, JUNE 15, 2027 | ANCIENT ROME

After breakfast, we explore Ancient Rome. We begin with a visit to the Colosseum – the largest of the ancient amphitheaters, completed in 80 AD – which served as the site for the torture and martyrdom of countless early Christians, among them Ignatius of Antioch and Telemachus. We continue with a walk through the Roman Forum, which contains the ruins of ancient Roman government buildings. We then visit the Mamertine Prison, where it is believed the Apostle Paul was once held, and stop at Circus Maximus – another site of ancient Christian martyrdoms. Overnight Rome. Hotel Orazio Palace or similar. B, D.

DAY 12: WEDNESDAY, JUNE 16, 2027 | ROME - FREE DAY

After breakfast, the day is yours to explore Rome at your own pace – whether shopping, visiting sites on your own, or simply savoring la dolce vita.

No transportation or guided tour services are included today. Overnight Rome. Hotel Orazio Palace or similar. B, D.

DAY 13: THURSDAY, JUNE 17, 2027 | DEPART

After a final breakfast, we check out and transfer to Rome airport (FCO) for our departure flight back to Miami. Upon arrival we board our motorcoach back to Calvary Port St. Lucie. B (if time permits).

CHRISTIAN EXPEDITION TERMS OF SERVICE

Itineraries: Itineraries are prepared and scheduled in advance according to the best information available at the time and are subject to change by the date of the trip.

Pricing: Christian Expedition, Inc. reserves the right to adjust pricing should the following occur; (1) Rise in Airfare due to higher fuel costs, etc. (2) Rise in ground costs due to increases in hotel charges, bus fares, fees, taxes and other costs due to the fluctuating value of the U.S. dollar against foreign currency.

Deposits and final payments: A deposit of \$450.00 per person is required to hold your reservation of which \$200 is non-refundable (may be refundable under travel insurance conditions). Final payment is due 90 days prior to the departure date. Payment can be made by credit card or check.

Cancellation fees: For cancellations received 90 days or more in advance of the trip's original departure date, all monies paid are refundable less \$200 per person. For cancellations received less than 90 days prior to the original departure date (even in the case of postponement), the initial deposit of \$450 plus any non-recoverable expenses associated with your reservation incurred by CE will be non-refundable. These expenses may include, but are not limited to, charges imposed by the airlines, hotels, and bus companies, the cost of labor associated with the servicing of your reservation, and the costs assessed for the use of our reservation system, as determined or estimated by CE. Please note that the amount may vary with each trip and the vendors we work with. CE retains the exclusive right to cancel or postpone any trip up to the departure date. If a trip is canceled by CE all funds received will be returned with-in 10 business days. If a trip is postponed by CE the cancellation fees enumerated above will remain in effect.

Baggage: Please follow the general rule of traveling light - If you cannot carry it do not bring it. Passengers are permitted one piece of luggage per person. Baggage handling is included for one suitcase per person only, whenever possible, in the cost of the trip. The airlines for international flights will not allow a suitcase exceeding 50 pounds (subject to change), if over 50lbs., the fees can be costly. Every effort will be made to handle luggage carefully, however Christian Expedition, Inc. will not assume any liability for lost or damaged luggage or items inside luggage carrier. (Travel insurance may apply)

Travel insurance: We strongly recommend the purchase of travel insurance (personal accident/trip cancellation/baggage insurance). Christian Expedition, Inc. cannot accept responsibility for accidents, trip cancellations, or handling of baggage not under our control. All categories of insurance may be purchased from Christian Expedition as provided by Allianz Travel Insurance.

Not Included: Drinks during meals other than while on cruise, lunches other than while on cruise, shore excursions other than those mentioned; please note that the only way to ensure priority disembarkation at Santorini is by booking a shore excursion, which costs approximately 100 euros per person, travel insurance, which can be obtained from Allianz via Christian Expedition at an additional cost, personal expenses, such as souvenirs, the cost of

meeting any travel or national entry requirements, including but not limited to the cost of obtaining or renewing a passport and the cost of obtaining a Visa or eVisa if required. It is expected that by the time of this trip travelers who are US citizens will need to obtain an EU ETIAS travel authorization, at an expected cost of approximately 20 EUR / 23 USD, anything not mentioned as being included.
