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CHRISTIAN EXPEDITION

Pastor Robb Williams invites you to join him for a life-changing journey through Israel. We have all studied the beauty and history of the Holy Land in Scripture; now, it is time to experience it for yourself.

Imagine the spiritual impact of sailing the Sea of Galilee, reading the Sermon on the Mount on the very ground where it was delivered, and literally walking the paths where Jesus walked. Pastor Robb will lead on-site meditations, giving you a chance to connect with God's Word in the places Jesus called home.

Please look over the enclosed itinerary and feel free to reach out with any questions. Let's make plans to walk the Holy Land together!

DAY 1: SATURDAY, MARCH 6, 2027: DEPART THE UNITED STATES

The day has arrived, and we depart the United States on an overnight air journey to Israel. Overnight in flight.

DAY 2: SUNDAY, MARCH 7, 2027: ARRIVE IN ISRAEL

We arrive in Israel at Ben Gurion Airport and are met by our Israeli guide. We will be greeted by our guide, and will make our way to our hotel. Take some time to rest or to explore the surrounding area. Tonight, we will enjoy a welcome dinner at our hotel. Overnight Tel Aviv area. Grand Beach or similar. D.

DAY 3: MONDAY, MARCH 8, 2027: CAESAREA MARITIMA, MEGIDDO, NAZARETH, MOUNT ARBEL

This morning we drive north to Caesarea Maritima or Caesara-by-the-Sea. We explore this ancient harbor where Peter once travelled in order to preach the Gospel to Cornelius and those assembled at his house. We visit the Tel of Megiddo, where we take in views of the Valley of Armageddon. We continue on Nazareth, visiting Nazareth Village to better understand first-century Jewish life, followed by the Church of the Annunciation and Mary's Well. We take in panoramic views from Mount Arbel, overlooking the Sea of Galilee and the surrounding area where Jesus ministered. Overnight Sea of Galilee area. Kibbutz Nof Ginosar (Village Rooms) or similar. B, D.

DAY 4: TUESDAY, MARCH 9, 2027: BOAT RIDE, CAESAREA PHILLIPI, CAPERNAUM, MOUNT OF BEATITUDES, CHORAZIN, MAGDALA

This morning we enjoy a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. We then travel to Caesarea Philippi, where Peter declared Jesus to be the Christ. Our day continues at Capernaum, Jesus' Galilean ministry base, and

the place where Jesus healed Peter's mother-in-law. We visit the the Mount of Beatitudes, Chorazin, and Magdala - all places where Jesus ministered in this region. Overnight Sea of Galilee area. Kibbutz Nof Ginosar (Village rooms) or similar. B, L, D.

DAY 5: WEDNESDAY, MARCH 10, 2027: BETH SHEAN, GAN HASHLOSHA, JERICHO, JERUSALEM

Leaving Galilee, we travel south through the Jordan Valley. We explore the Roman city of Beit Shean and then continue to Gan HaShlosa for an opportunity to be baptized. We visit Jericho, where we will see what could be the remains of the ramparts that Joshua and the Israelites brought down. We ascend to Jerusalem, visiting Mount Zion, the Western Wall, the Upper Room, and the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu. Overnight Jerusalem. Ambassador Boutique Hotel or similar. B, D.



DAY 6: THURSDAY, MARCH 11, 2027: JERUSALEM, BETHLEHEM

We depart early to visit the Temple Mount, followed by the Pools of Bethesda where Jesus healed a paralytic. Traveling to Bethlehem, we visit the Church of the Nativity and Shepherds' Fields, reflecting on Christ's birth. In the afternoon, we explore the Herodian fortress before concluding the day at Yad Vashem, Israel's Holocaust Memorial, and the Israel Museum, including the Shrine of the Book. Overnight Jerusalem. Ambassador Boutique Hotel or similar. B, D.



DAY 7: FRIDAY, MARCH 12, 2027: MASADA, EIN GEDI, QUMRAN, DEAD SEA

Today we journey into the Judean Desert. We ascend Masada by cable car, visit Ein Gedi where David hid from Saul, and explore Qumran, home of the Dead Sea Scrolls. We end the day floating in the mineral-rich waters of the Dead Sea (conditions permitting) before returning to Jerusalem. Overnight Jerusalem. Ambassador Boutique Hotel or similar. B, D.



MOUNT OF OLIVES

DAY 8: SATURDAY, MARCH 13, 2027: GARDEN TOMB & GORDON'S CALVARY, MOUNT OF OLIVES, GARDEN OF GETHSEMANE, CHURCH OF ALL NATIONS, VIA DOLOROSA, CHURCH OF THE HOLY SEPULCHER

We begin at the Garden Tomb and Gordon's Calvary, remembering Christ's death and resurrection. We continue to the Mount of Olives where we will take in magnificent views of Jerusalem. We visit the the Garden of Gethsemane, where Jesus agonized on the night before his crucifixion, and the nearby Church of All Nations. Walking the Via Dolorosa, we conclude

at the Church of the Holy Sepulcher, the possible location of Jesus' crucifixion, burial, and resurrection. This evening, we gather for a farewell dinner. If not participating in the extension, your flight home may depart late tonight or the following day. If the following day and an overnight is required, or if participating in extension, Overnight Jerusalem. Ambassador Boutique Hotel or similar. B, D.

DAY 9: SUNDAY, MARCH 14, 2027: ARRIVE AT HOME

If not participating in the extension, your flight may depart the previous night or today. If today and time allows, breakfast is included today. Either way, later today we will arrive back home at PIT or PHX.

OPTIONAL JORDAN EXTENSION

DAY 1: SUNDAY, MARCH 14, 2027: BETHANY BEYOND THE JORDAN, MOUNT NEBO

We depart early and cross into Jordan. Our first stop is Bethany Beyond the Jordan, traditionally recognized as the site of Jesus' baptism. We continue to Mount Nebo, where Moses viewed the Promised Land, before traveling south to Petra and checking into our hotel. Overnight Petra area. Petra Guest House or similar. B, D.

DAY 2: MONDAY, MARCH 15, 2027: PETRA

This morning we tour the rose-red city of Petra, entering through the Siq and emerging at the Treasury, with time to explore this remarkable Nabatean capital. In the late afternoon, we travel to Amman. Your flight home may depart either late tonight or the following day. If the following day and an overnight is required, overnight Amman. Opal or similar. B, D.

DAY 3: TUESDAY, MARCH 16, 2027: ARRIVE AT HOME

Your flight home may depart either the previous night or today. If today and time allows, breakfast is included today. Either way, later today we will arrive back at home in PIT or PHX.

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Pricing: Christian Expedition, Inc. reserves the right to adjust pricing should the following occur; (1) Rise in Airfare due to higher fuel costs, etc. (2) Rise in ground costs due to increases in hotel charges, bus fares, fees, taxes and other costs due to the fluctuating value of the U.S. dollar against foreign currency.

Deposits and final payments: A deposit of \$450.00 per person is required to hold your reservation of which \$200 is non-refundable (may be refundable under travel insurance conditions). Final payment is due 90 days prior to the departure date. Payment can be made by credit card or check.

Cancellation fees: For cancellations received 90 days or more in advance of the trip's original departure date, all monies paid are refundable less \$200 per person. For cancellations received less than 90 days prior to the original departure date (even in the case of postponement), the initial deposit of \$450 plus any non-recoverable expenses associated with your reservation incurred by CE will be non-refundable. These expenses may include, but are not limited to, charges imposed by the airlines, hotels, and bus companies, the cost of labor associated with the servicing of your reservation, and the costs assessed for the use of our reservation system, as determined or estimated by CE. Please note that the amount may vary with each trip and the vendors we work with. CE retains the exclusive right to cancel or postpone any trip up to the departure date. If a trip is canceled by CE all funds received will be returned within 10 business days. If a trip is postponed by CE the cancellation fees enumerated above will remain in effect.
