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CHRISTIAN EXPEDITION

DAY 1 — THURSDAY, MAY 13, 2027 | DEPART THE US

The day has arrived and we depart the United States on an overnight air journey to Greece.

Overnight: In flight.

DAY 2 — FRIDAY, MAY 14, 2027 | ARRIVE IN GREECE

Today we arrive in Greece at Thessaloniki Airport (SKG). We will be met by our guide and driver, who will bring us to our hotel in Kavala.

Meals: Dinner. Overnight: Kavala. Hotel Egnatia or similar.

DAY 3 — SATURDAY, MAY 15, 2027 | KAVALA, PHILIPPI, THESSALONIKI, ATHENS

We awake this morning in the place where Paul first made landfall on European soil. Like Paul, we travel from Kavala to Philippi, where Paul baptized Lydia, Europe's first Christian convert. Walk among the ruins of the agora, the basilica, and the prison where Paul and Silas sang hymns at midnight. We return to Thessaloniki for a review of Paul's ministry there, connecting the letters he wrote with Luke's account in the Book of Acts. We fly from Thessaloniki to Athens.

Meals: Breakfast, Dinner. Overnight: Athens. Zeus Essence Athens Central or similar.

DAY 4 — SUNDAY, MAY 16, 2027 | ATHENS

Today we will experience Athens. We will climb Mars Hill, where Paul famously preached to the Areopagus (Acts 17). Mars Hill sits in the shadow of the Acropolis, which we will also ascend. We will see the Parthenon, along with the Acropolis' other ancient structures. We enjoy some time in Athens' historic and renowned Plaka District.

Meals: Breakfast, Dinner. Overnight: Athens. Zeus Essence Athens Central or similar.

DAY 5 — MONDAY, MAY 17, 2027 | CRUISE EMBARKATION, MYKONOS

Transfer to the port of Piraeus and embark on your Aegean Cruise. This evening we arrive in Mykonos, where narrow whitewashed

DAY 6 — TUESDAY, MAY 18, 2027 | KUSADASI, EPHEBUS & PATMOS

Arrive in Kusadasi, Turkey, and enjoy your included excursion to Ancient Ephesus, where Paul stayed for nearly three years (Acts 19). Walk the marble streets to the theater where a crowd once gathered in opposition to Paul. We sail onward to Patmos, where John received the visions that now constitute the book of Revelation. We visit the Monastery of St. John and the Cave of the Apocalypse.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner. Overnight: Aboard Celestyal Cruise.

DAY 7 — WEDNESDAY, MAY 19, 2027 | RHODES

Today's stop is Rhodes, an island famed for its medieval walls, cobblestone lanes, and the legacy of the Knights of St. John. Explore the Palace of the Grand Masters or stroll the Old Town, where East meets West in stone and faith. The island's fortitude mirrors the courage of the early church amid opposition.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner. Overnight: Aboard Celestyal Cruise.

DAY 8 — THURSDAY, MAY 20, 2027 | CRETE & SANTORINI

Sail first to Crete, where Paul left Titus to "set in order what was left unfinished" (Titus 1:5). Continue to breathtaking Santorini, whose volcanic cliffs and blue-domed churches rise dramatically from the sea.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner. Overnight: Aboard Celestyal Cruise.

DAY 9 — FRIDAY, MAY 21, 2027 | CRUISE DISEMBARKATION, CORINTH

We make our way to Corinth, where Paul spent an extended amount of time. We will see the ruins of the ancient city including the bema where Paul appeared before Gallio. We will also see the pavement inscription mentioning Erastus, who was mentioned by Paul at Romans 16:23 and 2 Timothy 4:20.

Meals: Breakfast, Dinner. Overnight: Athens. Zeus Essence Athens Central or similar.

DAY 10 — SATURDAY, MAY 22, 2027 | FLIGHT HOME

We head to the airport, where we board our flight back home, or on to Rome.

ROME EXTENSION DAY 1 — SATURDAY, MAY 22, 2027 | ARRIVE ROME, VATICAN, CHRISTIAN ROME

This morning we fly from Athens to Rome. We will visit the Vatican, to include the Vatican Museums

and Sistine Chapel. Continue to the Abbey of the Three Fountains, recognized as the traditional site of Paul's beheading and an important reminder of the cost of early Christian witness. Walk the grounds and visit the chapel marking the apostle's final moments. Next, tour the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls, built over Paul's tomb and one of Rome's four major basilicas.

Meals: Breakfast, Dinner. Overnight: Rome. Starhotel Michelangelo or similar.

ROME EXTENSION DAY 2 — SUNDAY, MAY 23, 2027 | ANCIENT ROME & BAROQUE ROME

We visit the Colosseum; completed in 80 AD, it was the site of early Christian martyrdoms including those

of Ignatius of Antioch and Telemachus. We will explore the Roman Forum, which contains the ruins of ancient Roman government buildings. Then it's on to the Mamertine Prison, where Paul was once held. In the afternoon, we visit iconic Roman sites including the Pantheon, Trevi Fountain, and Spanish Steps.

Meals: Breakfast, Dinner. Overnight: Rome. Starhotel Michelangelo or similar.

ROME EXTENSION DAY 3 — MONDAY, MAY 24, 2027 | DEPART ROME

If time permits, breakfast is included today. We make our way to the airport and begin our journey back home, where we will arrive later in the day.

Meals: Breakfast (if time permits).

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Pricing: Christian Expedition, Inc. reserves the right to adjust pricing should the following occur; (1) Rise in Airfare due to higher fuel costs, etc. (2) Rise in ground costs due to increases in hotel charges, bus fares, fees, taxes and other costs due to the fluctuating value of the U.S. dollar against foreign currency.

Deposits and final payments: A deposit of \$450.00 per person is required to hold your reservation of which \$200 is non-refundable (may be refundable under travel insurance conditions). Final payment is due 90 days prior to the departure date. Payment can be made by credit card or check.

Cancellation fees: For cancellations received 90 days or more in advance of the trip's original departure date, all monies paid are refundable less \$200 per person. For cancellations received less than 90 days prior to the original departure date (even in the case of postponement), the initial deposit of \$450 plus any non-recoverable expenses associated with your reservation incurred by CE will be non-refundable. These expenses may include, but are not limited to, charges imposed by the airlines, hotels, and bus companies, the cost of labor associated with the servicing of your reservation, and the costs assessed for the use of our reservation system, as determined or estimated by CE. Please note that the amount may vary with each trip and the vendors we work with. CE retains the exclusive right to cancel or postpone any trip up to the departure date. If a trip is canceled by CE all funds received will be returned within 10 business days. If a trip is postponed by CE the cancellation fees enumerated above will remain in effect.

Baggage: Please follow the general rule of traveling light - If you cannot carry it do not bring it. Passengers are permitted one piece of luggage per person. Baggage handling is included for one suitcase per person only, whenever possible, in the cost of the trip. The airlines for international flights will not allow a suitcase exceeding 50 pounds (subject to change), if over 50lbs., the fees can be costly. Every effort will be made to handle luggage carefully, however Christian Expedition, Inc. will not assume any liability for lost or damaged luggage or items inside luggage carrier. (Travel insurance may apply)

Travel insurance: We strongly recommend the purchase of travel insurance (personal accident/trip cancellation/baggage insurance). Christian Expedition, Inc. cannot accept responsibility for accidents, trip cancellations, or handling of baggage not under our control. All categories of insurance may be purchased from Christian Expedition as provided by Allianz Travel Insurance.

Not Included: Lunches (other than while on the cruise), drinks at meals (other than while on the cruise), card fees (3% fee), personal expenses (souvenirs, laundry, etc.), Greek Government Sustainable Development Fee (estimated at a total of 36 euros per person; will be charged to shipboard account on cruise), the cost of meeting any travel or national entry requirements, including but not limited to the cost of obtaining or renewing a passport or the cost of

obtaining a Visa, eVisa, or Travel Authorization if and when required. Travels otherwise exempt from the necessity of obtaining a Visa will likely need to obtain an EU ETIAS at an approximate cost of 20 euros.
